Autumn 1: Being Me in My World

Questions discussed
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How can I face new challenges positively and set personal goals?• What are my rights and responsibilities as a citizen of my country? How do they compare with the experience of children in other countries?• What are my rights and responsibilities as a member of the Blisworth School community?• How can I make positive behaviour choices? How do I feel about rewards and consequences?• Can I give examples of how individual behaviour can affect others?• What is democracy? Why is it important that everyone's voice be heard? How can I contribute to my school community?

Autumn 2: Celebrating Difference

Questions discussed
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Why might cultural differences sometimes cause conflict?• What is racism?• Why are rumour-spreading and name-calling examples of bullying behaviour?• What is the difference between direct and indirect bullying and how might it make people feel? This lesson will cover different types of bullying including physical, emotional, texting and online bullying. It will give brief examples of each type of bullying including racial, homophobic, cultural and religious.• Should monetary wealth affect happiness? This will explore the idea of whether material wealth alone can contribute to happiness and encourage children to make their own reflections.• In what ways are other cultures similar and different to our own? This lesson includes making comparisons with other cultures to develop understanding and empathy.
