Curiosity

To use research and discussion to ask and answer questions about the past, thinking critically and developing perspective and judgement.

Courage

To use the achievements of the past to raise their own aspirations by broadening their experience and understanding of the wider world.

Perseverance

To take the time to weigh the evidence and sift through arguments before reaching a final conclusion.

Collaboration

To work together to share opinions, showing respect for the viewpoints of others.

To recognise the effects of past events on the present. Use lessons from the past to become a well-educated citizen of today.
